Want to extend your certification range and increase flexibility with special education teaching assignment options?

You are not alone! In June of 2018, the NYS Regents approved a [new certification pathway](#) for NYS special educators interested in extending their existing certification to address the growing shortage of certified special education teachers in NYS.

The 45 hour CTLE course series for the extension of certification includes three subset areas of learning: *Knowledge of Students, Instructional Strategies, and Professional Practice*. Each subset is 15 hours - five 3-hour sessions of learning specific to the content area.

NYSTC Courses now on the NYSED list of acceptable CTLE for the new extensions!

7-8 Special Education CTLE Certification Extension

This series provides the requisite minimum of 45 hours of acceptable CTLE focused on middle level education. Please note: eligible teachers must have a Student with Disabilities 1-6 NYS Certification and a minimum of 3 years teaching experience at 5th and/or 6th grade levels. Registrants are responsible for confirming their own eligibility.

The Grades 7-8 Students with Disabilities 45 hour CTLE certification extension series is 45 hours online and each module is 15 hours. The program will begin on Monday, April 13 and run until June 30, 2020.
